

YOUTH MINISTRY MASS TEXTING SYSTEM RETURNS

Parents, we've recently brought back a communication tool for getting info to your high school students. It's a simple mass text messaging system that they can sign up for, and then opt into. We'd like to offer you the same tool. Over the course of the month of October, I will be inputing your information into that tool, which means that at some point during the month, you should get a text from the number 40650 with a message that says, "Welcome to Church Info Alerts: Reply HELP for help. Msg&Data rates may apply. Msg freq will vary. Reply YES to enroll." This message is from the youth ministry and if you want to get text alerts about the happenings in the youth ministry, you just need to reply "Yes." You can ignore it if you don't want to get those alerts and you should never get a message from that number again. If for some reason by the end of the month you don't get this opt-in message and you would like to opt-in, please reach out and let us know so we can get you in our system.
