Sharing Life Together:

- 2. When have you felt Jesus being your anchor in the storm?

- 1. Read Genesis 12:1-3. How many times is the word Bless used in this passage? What stands out to you from this passage?
- 2. What is a biblical story that stands out to you of a comeback story? How did the turnaround bring blessings to others?
- 3. What are some challenges for you in feeling God's blessing in your life?
- 4. What successes have you had in evangelizing your friends, family, and neighbors? What challenges have you experienced?
- 5. What is your initial reaction of approaching evangelizing through the model of BLESS? What feels good?
 Does anything feel deficient?
- 6. When you consider the three things non-Christian friends want in spiritual conversations (listening without judgment, drawing their own conclusions, people who really live their own beliefs) what seems most natural and what seems most difficult? Why?
